### **Missionary's New Children's Book Shows Innovative Ways to Share Gospel**

GARLAND, TX—Texas native Viola Palmer has drawn on her years of experience as a Southern Baptist missionary in Honduras to write a children's story that demonstrates how missionaries meet dire human needs while they share the gospel in other countries.

Palmer's *The Man in the Green Jeep*, just released, tells the story through the eyes of Chico, a child in a poor Honduran town who is sent over the mountain to get help for his starving village. The help that arrives, in the form of compassionate missionaries, not only brings life-sustaining food and water but also the Bread of Life through Jesus Christ.

As she tells Chico's story, Palmer gives insight into innovative ways missionaries make Christ known as they teach people how to farm, plant trees, dig water wells, and raise rabbits while they tell about Jesus. It also gives a captivating glance into children's lives and culture in Central America.

The book contains a study guide for leaders of children's groups.

Palmer and her husband, Jim, for 25 years have been career missionaries, serving in both Honduras and Nicaragua. Previously she served as children's minister.
